Sundar means “beautiful” in Sanskrit. The Sundar Prize Film Festival celebrates beautiful and impactful cinema that raises awareness, strengthens understanding, and inspires action.

In only three completed editions, the Sundar Prize Film Festival has grown from an ambitious new cultural initiative into a four day, multi venue festival welcoming nearly 2,000 attendees and presenting 63 films. Its 2026 campaign generated more than 2.26 million known views and impressions, with exceptional organic discovery across social platforms.

The 2027 festival offers sponsors an opportunity to join this momentum, reach engaged audiences, support filmmakers, and demonstrate a meaningful commitment to arts, culture, inclusion, and community impact.

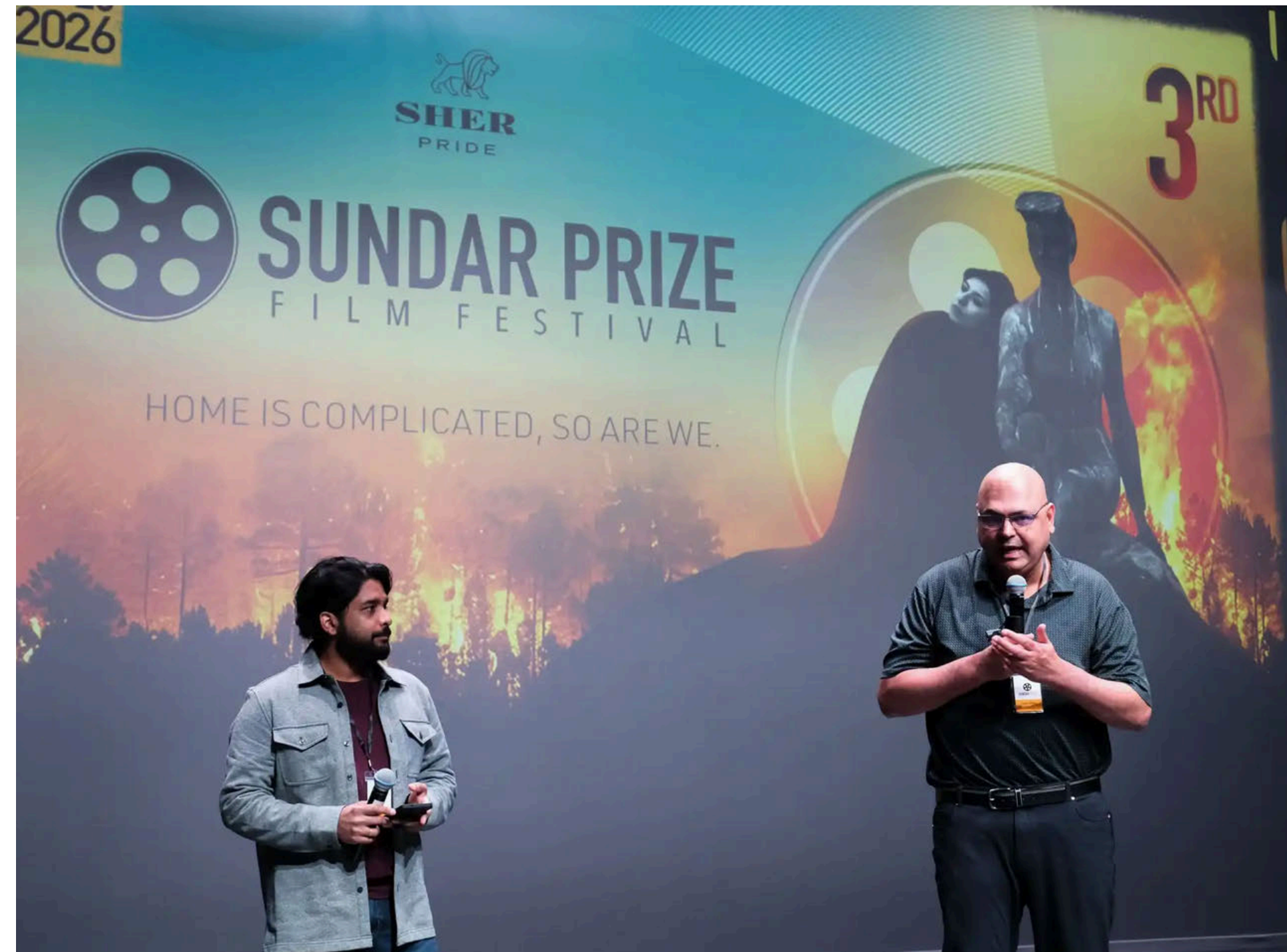


Built on Community Leadership and Filmmaking Experience

The festival was founded by social worker and documentary producer, Amar Sangha, and filmmaker, Vinay Giridhar, to create a professional platform for cinema that advances understanding, representation, and social change.

Together with Executive Director and Senior Programmer Sidartha Murjani, they have guided Sundar Prize from its inaugural edition into a growing international festival rooted in filmmaker care, community engagement, and meaningful storytelling.

Ruzic also volunteers year round with the Vancouver International Film Festival and helped expand youth engagement at Sundar Prize by spearheading the Sundar Prize Luminaries Program in 2025.
